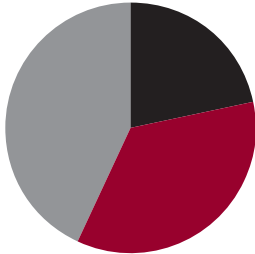

Orangeburg County residents with a bachelor's degree on average **earn 57% more** than those with only a high school diploma.

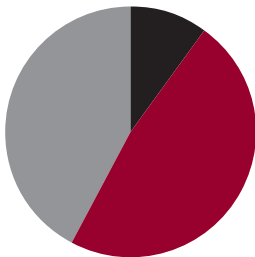
USC SYSTEM REVENUE SOURCES

Statewide Impact of the University of South Carolina

The total economic impact of the University of South Carolina (including all eight campuses throughout the state) is approximately \$5.5 billion when measured in terms of annual state output – the total annual dollar value of goods and services associated with increases in alumni wages and business activity resulting from non-state funded expenditures. This total state impact also supports 60,250 jobs.
