

Cherokee County residents with a bachelor's degree on average **earn 42% more** than those with only a high school diploma.



Statewide Impact of the University of South Carolina

The total economic impact of the University of South Carolina (including all eight campuses throughout the state) is approximately \$5.5 billion when measured in terms of annual state output — the total annual dollar value of goods and services associated with increases in alumni wages and business activity resulting from non-state funded expenditures. This total state impact also supports 60,250 jobs.
